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Objectives:

The working group is finalised to outline the following learning approaches for environmental education, contained in the UNESCO programme "TLSF":

- •Learning through Experience: students / citizens are encouraged in critical thinking, problem solution and make decision approach;
- •Learning through Enquiry: students / citizens are made more active and responsible in their investigation and about their own knowledge;
- •Learning for the Community: the aim of the education process is to help students / citizens to learn how to think and to solve the real issues of their local community



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Activities:

- Phase 1: choose one of the following environmental thematic areas to develop an environmental communication /education tool: Air; Water; Soil; Nature and
- Biodiversity; Waste; Energy and Radiation; Demography and Economy;
- Phase 2: Define the target population to which address the tool

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- Phase 3: Develop some pages for an interactive tool of environmental education, containing the following aspects:
- Description of the issue
- Practical exercises (quiz, test, play) to assess one's own knowledge
- Key messages to change behaviours
- Phase 4: Final presentation of the working group's activities
