APAT Experiences

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1. The European Union Projects experiences (PASS 2 and PASS 3)

- The EU PASS 2 and PASS 3 Project are examples of external training management.
- The management of these environmental Projects has been developed through a sub-contract to external firms according to training needs expressed by Environmental Protection Agencies.
- The management of this projects includes various aspects, even if developed in different centres, such as:
- The organization of environmental training;
- The selection and involvement of teachers and experts;
- •The location of classrooms:
- The assurance of safety and emergency standards' implementation;
- •The verification of the instruments and equipments needed to carry out laboratories and outdoor training activities;

The ACNA National project included the definition of responsibilities and roles for experts in charge of ocupational health and human safety (Italian L. 626/94) for the training project activities, also including stage activities foreseen by the project.


The safety responsible (by Italian L. 626/94) is in charges of the following activities:

- Risk analysis and mitigation of training activities sites including also laboratory and exercises facilities;
- To plan preliminary project for laboratories activities;
- To select a team leaders for safety aspects coordination during activities;

- to prepare laboratories' maps with all safety indications;
- to prepare safety report for safety Authorities;





- to check laboratories equipments (for example Fire extinguishers);
- to prepare depliants about main information of safety aspects and to distribute it to participants;
- •to delivery accident-prevention materials and to keep updated participants' registration of attendance;

- To care of standards' obligations for all works safety, during exercises activities (Italian L. 42496);
- •To care of works safety during all exercises

In order to facilitate the management of training courses, the implementation of ACNA National Project included all admmistrative activities, such as:

- •to prepare and administer the documents and contracts for real estate renting for the training centre offices;
- to provide, purchase and supply durable goods;
- to manage the registries of purchasing didactical materials, including the management of minute cash;
- to manage the contracts with teachers, tutors, experts and administrative and recruitment personnel;
- to keep updated the registration and to protocol all documents in entrance and in exit related to the administration of the centre;



3. APAT procedures

APAT at moment performs training activities in its centres according to the Italian Law n. 61/1994 and DG/02/2003 taking care of programmes for the diffusion of knowledge and capacity building in environmental protection matters, by means of various learning methodologies.



In this contest APAT promotes environmental protection courses training for the technical-scientific support to the Ministry of the Environment and Territorial Protection and other Public Institutions through specific agreements.

During the implementation of training courses promoted, occupational health and human safety aspects are under the Italian 626/94 Law responsibilities and roles (APAT occupational health responsible), while outdoors training activities are ruled by specific procedures.



3. APAT procedures

At the moment APAT Service for Environmental Education and Capacity Building has already performed the following procedures for:

- a) Internship and Stage environmental training activities;
- b) Training Courses Procedure;
- C) Environmental E-Learning procedure.

Besides, all activates performed are under APAT responsibility for all occupational health and human safety aspects, that by Italian Law 626/94 are in charge by APAT Direction by means of qualified experts, as for all other APAT activities and documented in a specific Safety Reports.
