## 1. Objective

The case study is finalised to the application of indicators in the different stages of an EIA process.

## 2. Activities

- a) Exhibition by participants of the environmental impact studies for the check of indicators applicability
- b) Division of the participants into groups for the application of the method; choice of a project for each group for controlling of the above check (possibly diversifying the projects by typology of intervention or by territorial context of reference)
- c) Division of studies into different stages of the process

## 2. Activities

- d) Compilation of the indicators check-lists divided by stages, environmental elements and categories of DPSIR
- e) Characterization of one indicator for processing stage through the use of the type-scheme mentioned during the first day
- f) Application of the selected indicators in the various stages of the chosen environmental impact studies

## 2. Activities

- g) Discussion and debate about the effectiveness of performed choices and about the possible deepening and/or variations that the project could undergo by utilizing the methodology of indicators
- h) Discussion and debate about the follow up on future planning that the use of the indicators could give rise (environmental quality maps, sensitive maps, criticality maps, and so on...)
