# First steps

First contact: via administration (recommendation of Bernd Vts1 kler, WA2, NÖ LR)

First meeting: administration and civil engineer, Umweltbundesamt Introduction of the DANUBE FLOODRISK project and the planned pilot activities; illustration of consequences of involvement; discussion of possible pilot areas and scenarios

Administration and civil engineer: generally interested in participating in pilot activities (esp. in getting more flood information), have to ask political agreement (esp. regarding public participation)

**Second meeting:** politician, administration and civil engineer, Umweltbundesamt Introduction pilot activities of DF; discussion of desired pilot area and getting agreement for pilot activities

- Politician: fears negative media attention first community in Austria with risk maps; Umweltbundesamt = alien (don't know about us, no relationship)
- Administration: want to get data + maps, positive, good relationship with the politician
