WHAT IS THE EU DOING?

EU Regulation on IAS Negative List of prohibited species slow & burdensome updating process.



What is a Positive List?

A list of species allowed to be traded and kept as pets by the general public



A single List to guarantee:

Animal Welfare
Animal Health
Human Health and Safety
Environmental Protection





Toy vs living animal




- No sharp edges
- Parts (eg eyes) secure
- Cleanable
- Fire resistant
- ID labels confirm safe standards
- ÷



Bite, scratch Easily harmed Impossible to clean Almost certainly infective Virtually impossible to care for well ID labels would confirm unsafe

BELGIUM AND THE POSITIVE LIST: A SUCCESS STORY



5 objective criteria:

 Easy to keep and capable of being given shelter with respect for fundamental animal needs
No particular danger to human health

 No threat to local fauna if escape
Bibliographic data on the keeping of the species is available
Conflict between data/insufficient data: benefit of the doubt goes to the animal.

General derogation:

- Zoological gardens
- Circuses
- Laboratories
- Private persons
 - → Animals already in possession
 - → With a license





HISTORY

- 2001: Royal Decree fixing a list of 42 mammal species
- Possibility for private persons to obtain a license for keeping other species
- Evaluation on scientific basis





HISTORY



Legal challenges:

- Quantitative restrictions on imports and all measures having equivalent effect shall be prohibited between member states;
- Positive list is not proportionate to the objective pursued

Andibel ruling (2008, European Court of Justice):

- Restrictions may be justified for protection of the environment
- Animal welfare is a legitimate objective in the public interest
- List must be based on objective, non discriminatory criteria
- A procedure must exist for adding new species to the list.
- New Royal Decree

THE NETHERLANDS AND THE POSITIVE LIST

- 2014: Wageningen UR Livestock Research was requested to identify a methodology to assess the species to be included in the list.
- 2015: Adoption of the PL Ministerial Decree
- > 2017: traders' lawsuit
- > 2018: new committee convened





CONCLUSIONS

- Scientific and objective approach
- Procedure to add species
- > No legal objections
- Enforcement is easy
- > Yes, prevention is better than cure!
