

Copernicus Marine Service conbtributes to coastal managemeent and environmental impact assessment

COASTAL DOWNSCALING

Thanks to a modeling method called "Downscaling" the Copernicus Marine Service can be used for coastal management. For example, harbor authorities can model pollution by mud and sediments during dreding operations of fish habitats.

WATER POLLUTION

The European Marine Strategy Framework Directive (MSFD) has set up an agenda for achieving clean marine waters in Europe by 2020. In this context, sea water eutrophication can be monitored by each European Member State using the Copernicus Marine Service.

OFFSHORE ENERGY

Several technologies have emerged to harness the energy of the seas. The Copernicus Marine Service ocean models provide key input to estimate the ocean energy resources. minimize the risks and help with the mandatory environmental monitoring of offshore sites.

SHIP ROUTING

Ship routing allows maritime shipping companies to reduce fleet navigation risks, save fuel and reduce CO2 emissions. The Copernicus Marine Service products provide input conditions for ship routing software for safer navigation routes including ice covered areas.

SEARCH AND RESCUE

The principal mission of Search and Rescue Coast Guards is to reduce risks at sea. The Copernicus Marine Service products provide input for search and rescue software and met-ocean dashboards to reduce risk at sea

SUSTAINABLE FISHERY MANAGEMENT

A new sustainable strategy for fisheries is becoming possible thanks to numerical modelling of the marine ecosystem and its food chain from small organisms to top predators. The Copernicus MarineService products are used in modelling

AQUACULTURE FARM SITING AND MANAGEMENT

The selection of appropriate siting of aquaculture farms is crucial for their long-term sustainability and depends on many parameters. Copernicus Marine Service products are used to provide support to water quality monitoring in such

COMBAT AGAINST HARMFUL ALGAE BLOOM

Anoxic waters and Harmful Algae Bloom (HAB) affect most biota negatively, including fishes. The Copernicus Marine Service products provide precious input to monitor water quality and potential HAB.

The Copernicus Marine Service 'Ocean State Report' synthetizes the Global Ocean and European Seas state and health for the preceding 20 years. It furthers knowledge for the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC), the ocean scientific community as well as for policy and decision makers.

SEASONAL FORECAST

At seasonal time scales, predictability of atmospheric behavior mainly depends on the state of the ocean, especially for tropical zones. The Copernicus Marine Service provides data for the seasonal prediction of events such as El Niño/La Niña.

MULTI MODEL ENSEMBLE UNCERTAINTIES Multi model ensembles using a combination of the
