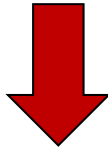

dati 2020

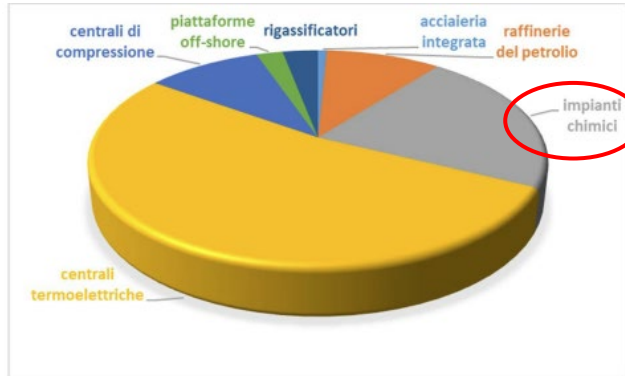


Italy \approx 6.500 plants under IED (= AIA)

>> 29 chemical plants (22%)

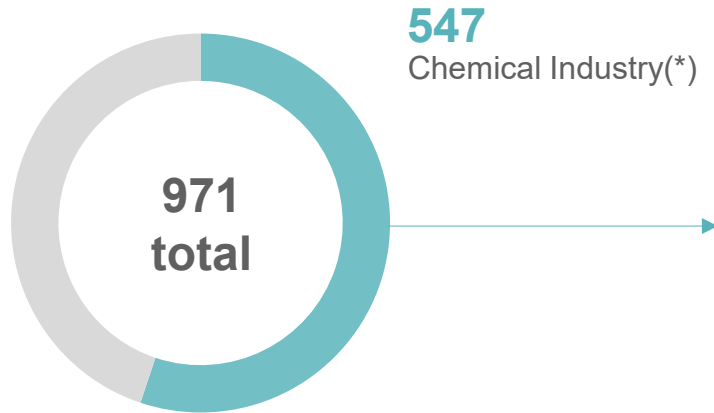


- \approx 6.400 under regional competence

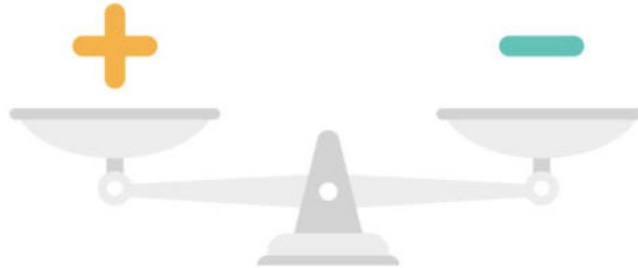

Initial thought on the integration of IED-SEVESO controls

- ✓ IED and Seveso inspections are **important and demanding**, both in terms of time and contents.
- ✓ Chemical companies are interested in **integrating, standardizing**, and making the 2 inspections **more efficient**.
- ✓ A willingness to **work together**, in a collaborative spirit, through Confindustria, to identify the best solution for the public authority and operators, considering possible involvement in the National Coordination Committee for the uniform application of Seveso.
- ✓ The need to **clearly identify the areas** common to both inspections (e.g. management system).
- ✓ The need to **plan and schedule** inspections to enable the Operator to organise the team and the documentation.
- ✓ **Document submission in advance** by the Operator and/or organization of a **preparatory virtual meeting** to reduce the time spent by inspectors at the plant.

Pros & Cons on the integration of IED-SEVESO controls

- ✓ Optimisation of the time required to provide documents, information and feedback common to both inspections
- ✓ Integration of requests give a complete vision of the plant
- ✓ Elimination of the possibility of issuing conflicting requirements/observations
- ✓ Optimisation of the number of days dedicated to inspections
- ✓ Great commitment from staff dedicated to HSE and related issues
- ✓ Difficulty in simultaneously managing specific requests for IED checks and Seveso checks
- ✓ Any difficulties in coordinating the 2 teams of inspectors
