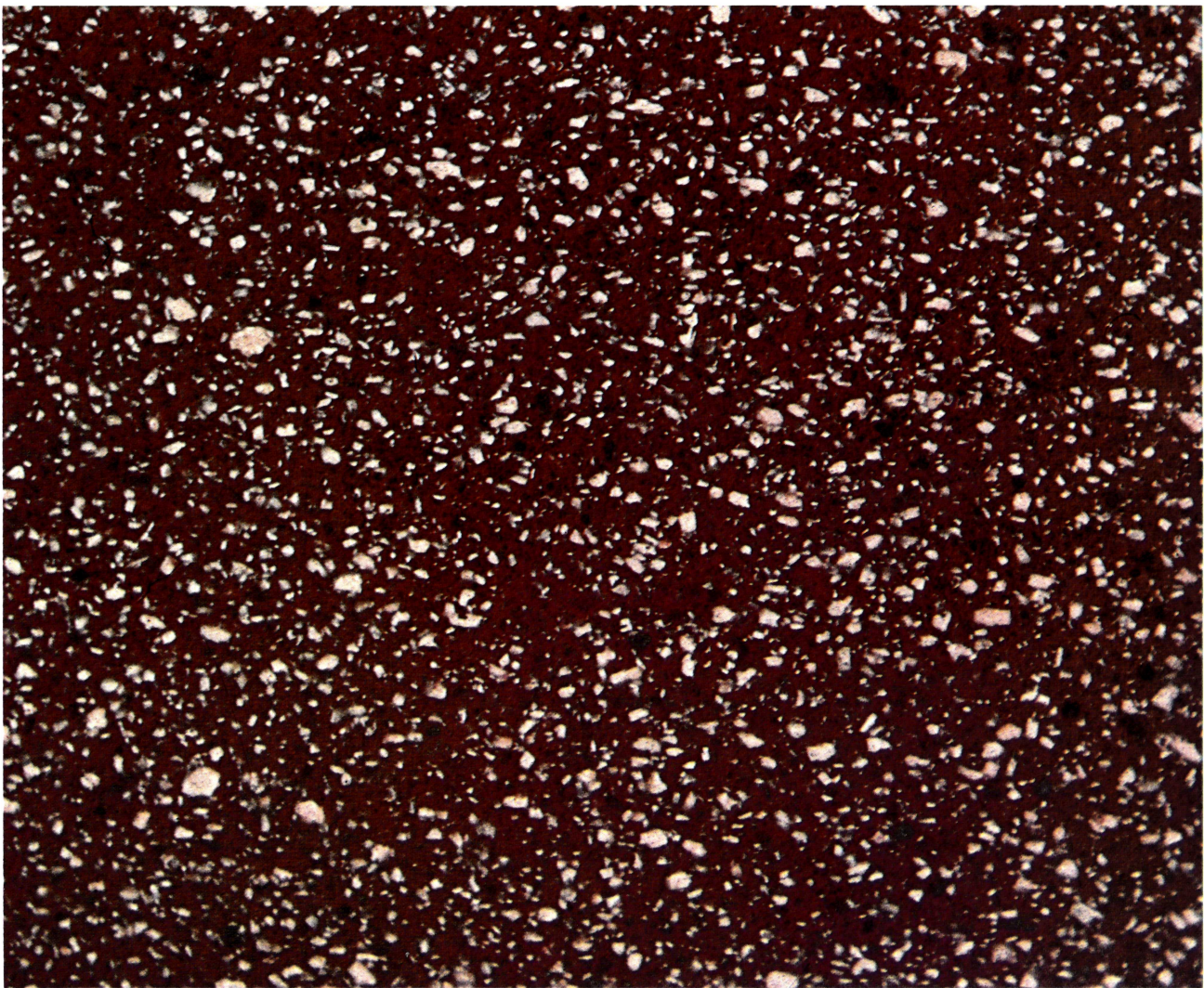


FIG. 212. – *Campione 23: PORFIDO ROSSO – Porfrite rossa*

Sample 23: RED PORPHYRY – Red porphyrites

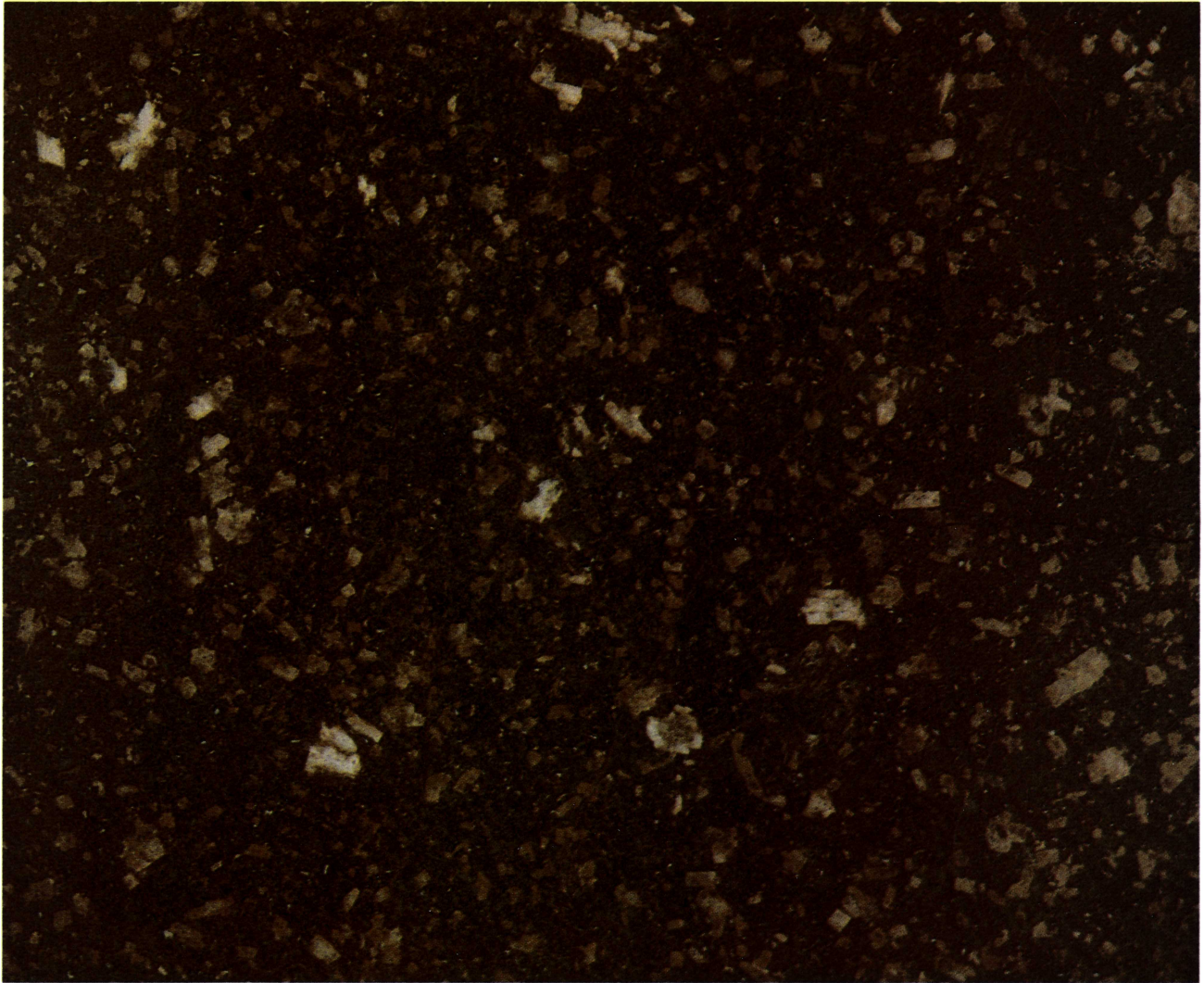


FIG. 213. - *Campione 24*: PORFIDO VERDE - Diabase Porfiroide

Sample 24: GREEN PORPHYRY - *Porphyritic Diabase*

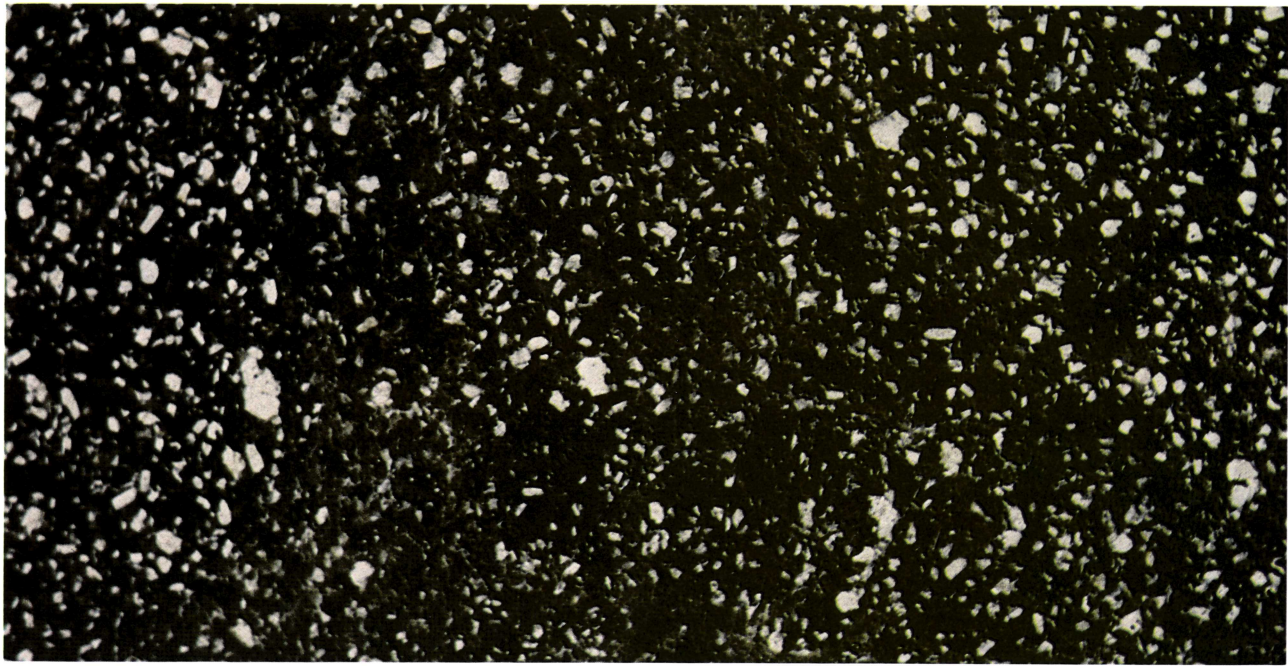


FIG. 214. – *Campione 25: PORFIDO NERO MACCHIATO VERDE – Diabase porfiroide*

In the Church of Aracoeli the columns of the Altar in the seventh Chapel on the right, are in green spotted black porphyry.

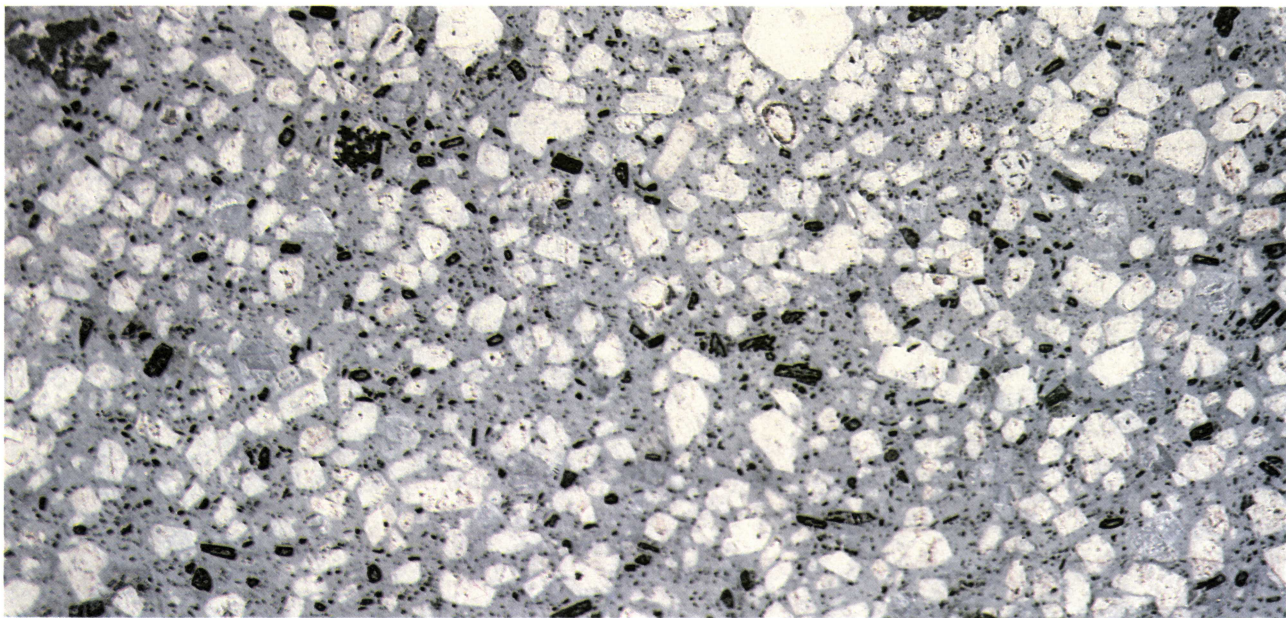


FIG. 215. – *Campione 26: PORFIDO BIGIO A MORVIGLIONE anche noto come VERMIGLIONE – Porfido grigio quarzifero*

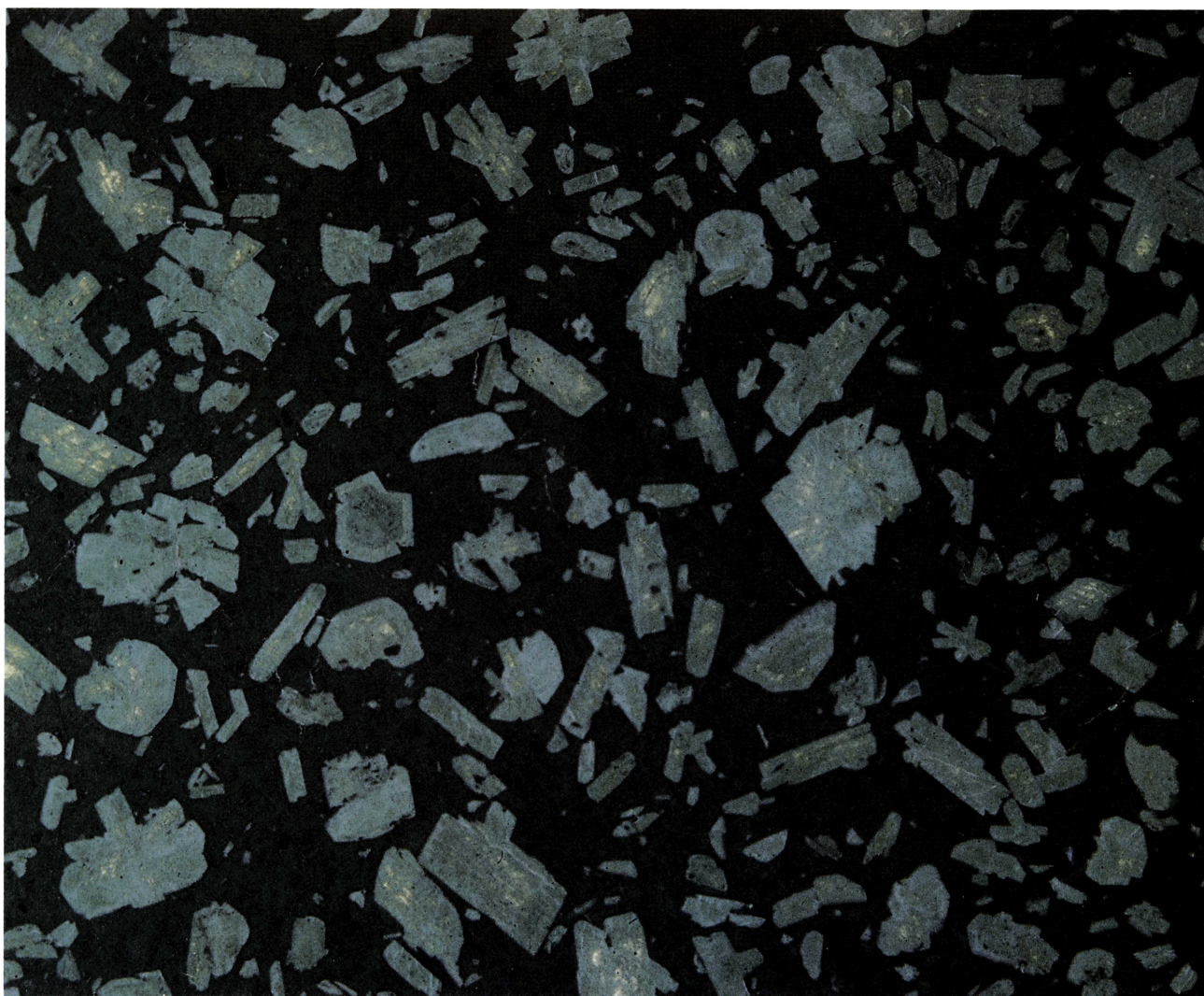


FIG. 216. – Campione 27: SERPENTINO VERDE A FONDO BRUNO – Porfirite Diabasica

** Improperly named Serpentine.

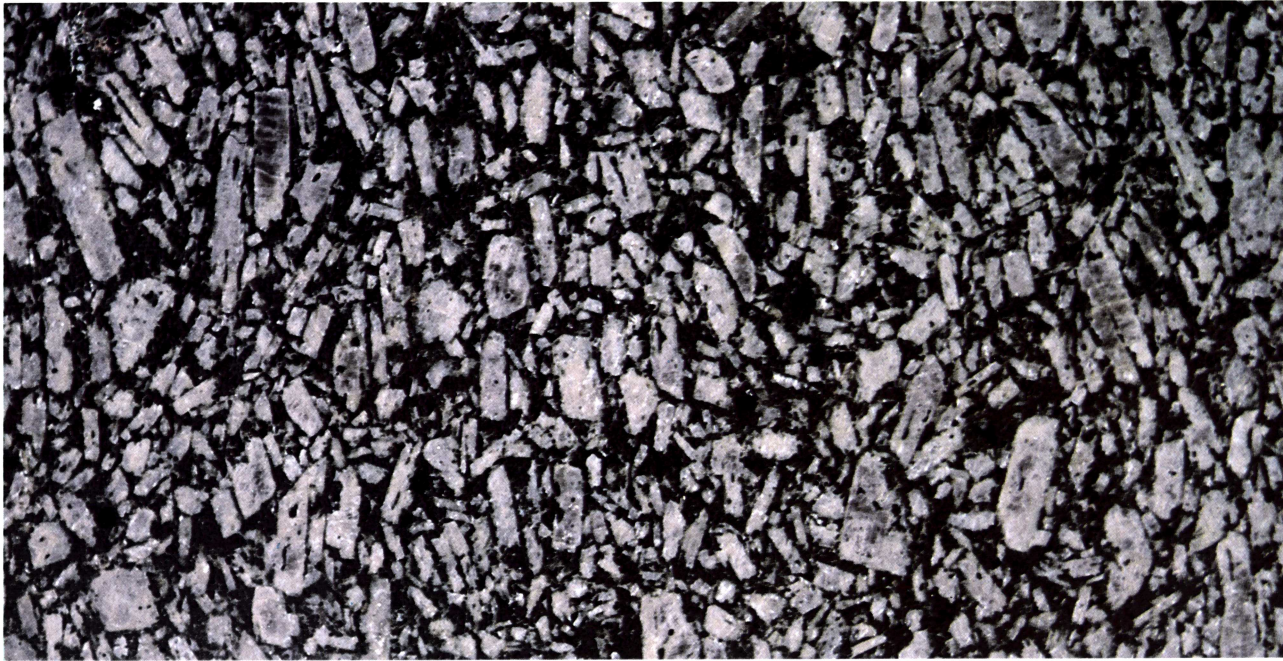


FIG. 217. – *Campione 28: SERPENTINO VERDE SCURO MINUTO – Porfirite Diabasica*

Sample 28: *MINUTE DARK GREEN SERPENTINE – Diabasic Porphyrites*

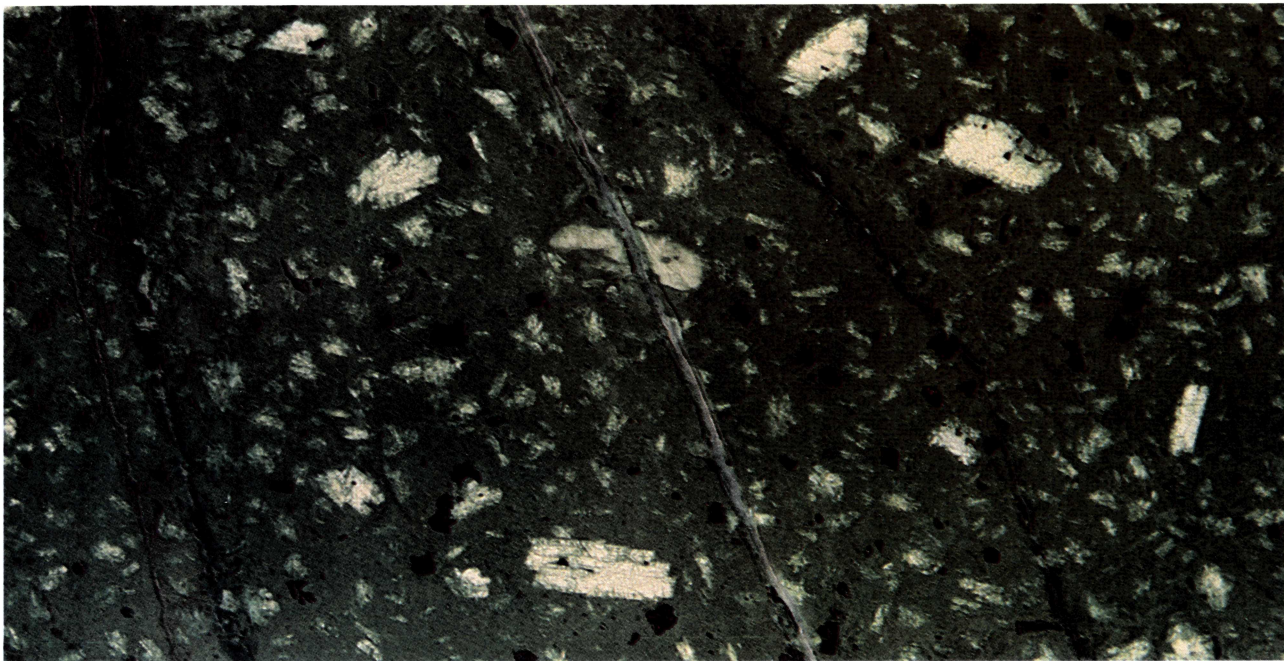


FIG. 218. – *Campione 29: SERPENTINO RISATO – Porfirite Diabasica*

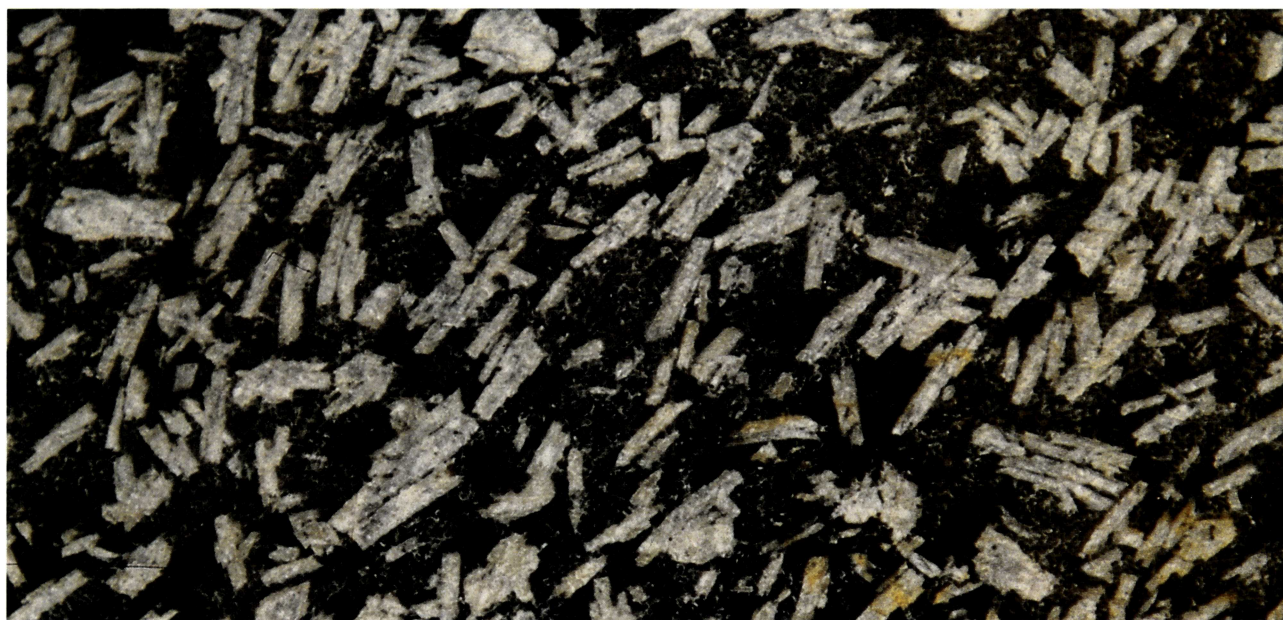


FIG. 220. - *Campione 31*: SERPENTINO NERO DURO - Porfirite Diabasica
